Create a rainbow from memory!

Rainbow Road

2-6 players, Required Time: 10-15 minutes, Difficulty: ★☆☆

*The Deck

Use all seven suits. You will not use the rainbow card.

*Object of the Game

Remember where each color hides and collect as many sets of all seven colors as possible.

*Set-Up

Shuffle all the cards, place them face down, then draw one card and set it aside without looking at it. This card will not be used for this game. The remaining cards are arranged in rows face down on the table.

*How to play

The first player begins turning cards face up. He or she may keep turning over cards as long as each card is a different color. When seven different color cards are turned over, the player takes the cards and keeps them in a pile. If the player turns over a second card of the same color before they make a rainbow, they must return all the cards to their original, face down position.



The first three cards Player A turned over are all different colors; however, the fourth card is the same color as one of the other cards (red). Player A must return all of his or her cards to their original, face down position. After that, it becomes Player B's turn.

*Game Over

When only six cards are left, the game is over. The player who has the greatest number of sets is the winner.

*Easier Rule

- I. Use only five suit colors instead of all seven. When 4 cards are left on the playing surface, the game is over.
- 2. Instead of making a rainbow, collect sets of two or three of the same color cards.

*Extended Rule

Players many only collect a set of cards if they turn them over in the right order (the order indicated on the rainbow card: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, pink).
